

Chapel of Our Lady of Locmaria

The Notre-Dame de Locmaria chapel, listed as a Historic Monument, is the oldest religious building in the town. It houses a polychrome frame from the 15th century, which was restored in 2009. This frame and its paintings are exceptional because of their rarity. The whole decor is remarkable because...






in Erdeven

Lann Groez Chapel

It has a full-length granite bench and a doorway with ornate pilasters dating from the late 16th century. Wooden altar behind which is a paneled altarpiece. On the sides, two false niches without a statue. In the south wall, a shelf in a niche framed by small columns with 16th century capitals.

Chapel of the Seven Saints

Refurbished in 1899. It quickly fell into disrepair and attempts to protect it only accelerated its decline. Sanctuary of Ste-Anne d'Auray

The history of Sainte-Anne d'Auray would have started in the 17th century, with the apparitions of Saint Anne, mother of Marie, to Yves Nicolazic, pious laborer of the village. At the time, Ste-Anne d'Auray was a hamlet called Ker Anna, the "village of Anne" in Breton. During an apparition, she...



in Camors

Saint Sane

The most notable is the altarpiece of the south chapel. It provides in relief, with brutal realism, the scene of the beheading of John the Baptist (decapitation). According to records, the church Saint-Sane dates of 1640. However, it has been amended by annexes which have been grafted to the ship...



Church of St Peter and St Paul

Dating from 1755, the bell tower, all in granite, consists of a square tower surmounted by an octagonal part ending in a lantern. The aisles came to widen the nave from 1832, giving it its current appearance. On the gable of the south is leaned a cross whose granite base bears the date of 1851.

Chapel of St. Germain

It has been restored several times. The date 1635 can be read in the wall of the chevet, against which is leaned an altarpiece made of rectangular compartments, in the center a square painting representing the Repentance of Saint Peter. There are several side niches bearing statues.

St Savior Chapel

It keeps its typical aspect of the Breton Renaissance. Western facade with a molded arched door, original bell tower dominated by a short spire. The southern facade retains its long wall bench and a semicircular doorway between two flat pilasters, and three windows, one of which has a pointed arch.

Chapel of Our Lady of Gornevec

The chapel was built in the 11th century by the monks of St. Gildas Rhuys, who owned property and land in the village. The site was still flourishing in the 19th century, attended by nurses who came to pray for an abundant milk. In the 20th century, its roof collapsed and the chapel fell into...

The Charterhouse

The Chartreuse was built following the battle of Auray which opposed Jean de Montfort to his cousin and rival Charles de Blois, for the Duchy of Brittany. The confrontation cost the life of Charles de Blois and put an end to the War of Succession of Brittany. In 1382, Jean IV de Montfort, who...

Saint-Gildas Church

From the 17th century, listed furniture including the major altarpiece and the 16th century recumbent statue of Christ. Open daily from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
